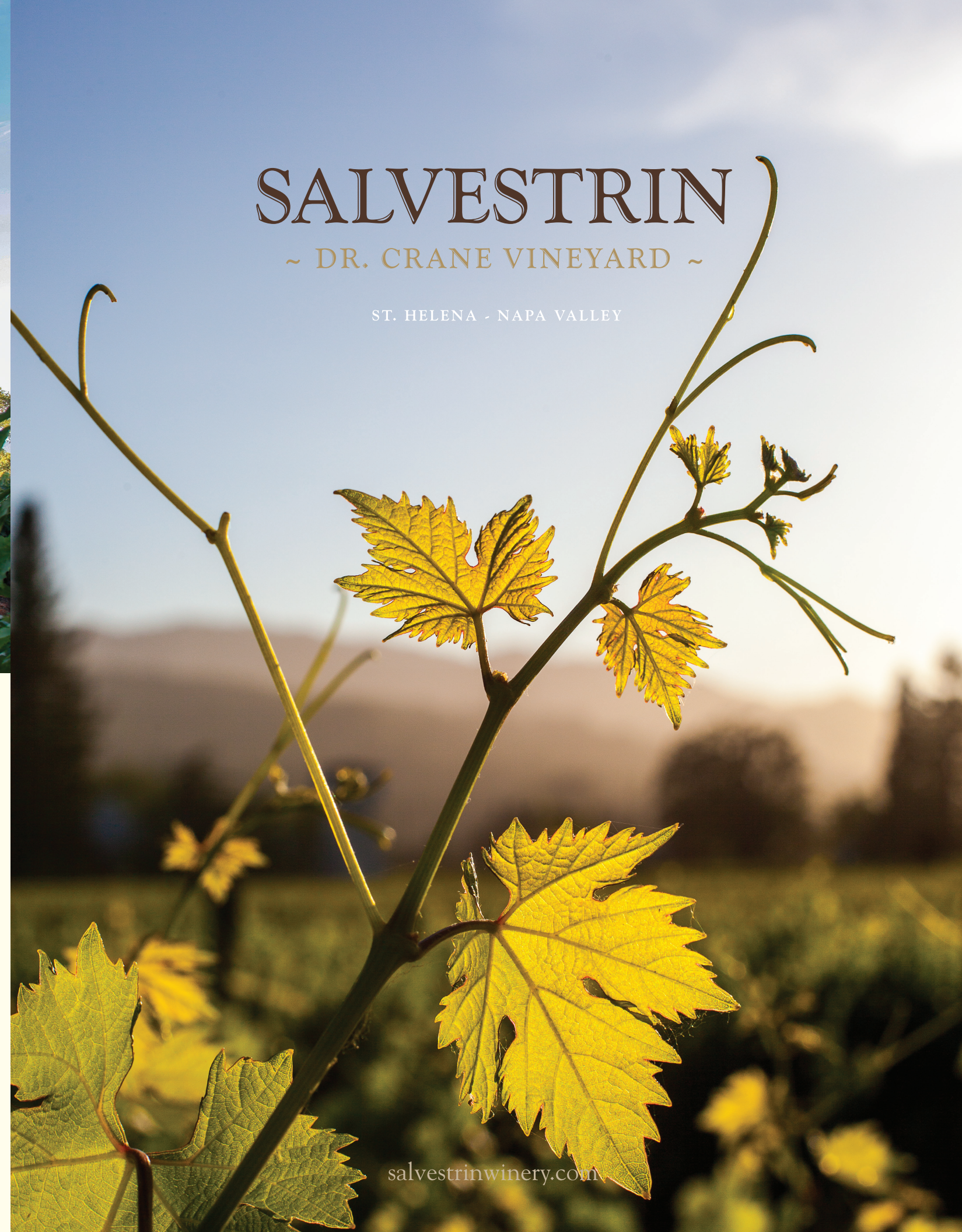

*Salvestrin Winery was just named in the top ten undiscovered iconic wineries by Legendary Napa Valley.*

Dr. George Belden Crane settled in St. Helena in the 1850's and began planting grapevines by 1859. He purchased approximately 300 acres on what is now the south end of town. By the 1870's, Crane had planted about 100 acres of vineyard and built a winery. Dr. Crane was known as a pioneering viticulturist and was the first to plant European varietals in Napa Valley. Crane died in 1898, but the property continued to be owned and operated by family until the 1920's. At that point it was parceled and sold.

In 1932 Italian immigrants John and Emma Salvestrin settled in the Napa Valley and saved enough for a down payment to purchase Dr. Crane's original home and 23 acres of his vineyard. They lived in the home and farmed the land their entire life with each generation teaching the next how to care for the land and tend the vines. The Salvestrin family has been farming the land for three generations and is now mentoring the fourth generation. Grapes grown from the Salvestrin-Dr. Crane vineyard were sold to various Napa wineries from 1932 – 1994.

As a third-generation grape grower, Rich Salvestrin learned the art of farming on the family estate from his father and grandfather. After college, he gained experience at Mumm, S. Anderson Winery and as COO of the

California Grapevine Nursery, and then he expanded the family's grape growing business to include winemaking. The inaugural vintage of Salvestrin Cabernet Sauvignon was in 1994, and in 2001 the estate winery was constructed among the vines. 2012 was the first vintage to use the Salvestrin-Dr. Crane Vineyard designation on the 3D Cabernet Sauvignon, and now all wines made from the vineyard include the designation of the good doctor.

The Salvestrins are the only family who have a physical winery located on the Dr. Crane vineyard and who produce estate bottled wines. A small handful of other families own nearby parts the Dr. Crane vineyard, however they sell the fruit to various wineries who designate the vineyard on the label.

The Napa County Farm Bureau recognized Rich as the Outstanding Agriculturist of the Year in 2014. Rich believes in making wines that show the story of his family's grape growing lifestyle in the Napa Valley and that are authentic expressions of what we do on a daily basis. He believes in balance: balance in our lives, in ourselves and in our wines. He strives to make wines that are enjoyable and that pair beautifully with food. We hope you agree.

CRYSTAL SPRINGS VINEYARD  
ST. HELENA, NAPA VALLEY

A blend of three distinct Sauvignon Blanc clones, our 2018 is bright and lively featuring Meyer lemon, key lime zest, and pineapple. Playfully tropical on the palate, the slight mid palate creaminess imparted by partial neutral oak aging is balanced out with fresh, youthful acidity. Layered with different textures, this wine is persistent and features a touch of minerality long after the last sip. It pairs well with oysters, a variety of fish, and oven grilled chicken.

This majestic Cabernet opens with notes of plum, Italian leather, fresh tobacco leaf, black olive, and a trace of white pepper. Robust and rich, this opulent wine features mouth-coating tannins that are refined, powdery, and slightly chalky. Structured yet smooth, black cherry comes through on the long, lingering finish.

Black cherry and blackberry are the first aromatics to shine through on this elegant Cabernet. Full bodied and rich, the tannins are firm yet refined, commanding a robust plush quality. Hints of barrel spices reveal a slight toastiness, which is complemented by cigar box, leather, and plum on the back end. This wine has great length – it is delicious now but also is sure to age for at least a decade.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

DR. CRANE VINEYARD

Our prized 3D Cabernet spends almost three years aging in new French oak barrels. This prolonged aging process allows the wine to become harmonious and seamless in texture. Fine grain tannins provide ample structure, and the core of currants, blackberry, plum and black olive shine through. Layered and complex, hints of spearmint, licorice, and a slight barrel toastiness can also be discovered. This wine is delightfully approachable, but is also sure to age exquisitely – drink now or lay it down for 15 years (you will be rewarded.)
